Chiltern Pale Ale - Excellent quaffing ale - light and refreshing with hints of grapes and honey. Brewed in Buckinghamshire by the gentlemen of the Chiltern Brewery.

Britannia Imperial IPA - Medium bodied and light made with English hops. A balanced sweet and bitter finish.

Conqueror Black I.P.A. - A rich, complex and very distinctive ale. A blend of 5 speciality malts to give an intense roasted flavour and a fresh pine hop aroma.

Olde Trip - A rich, toffee flavoured beer with a fruity character and a clean, bitter finish.

Guardsman - English Best Bitter brewer with premium floor malted Maris Otter and traditional whole leaf hops including Fuggles and Goldings.

Windsor & Eton Republika Lager - A refreshing Pilsner, brewed by our friends at Windsor and Eton Brewery

Cotswold Premium Lager - Craft made & natural - best of all its unpasteurised. Lager brewing practices are inspired by the German purity law of 1516, which means that our beers are preservative free and cold stored for at least 4 weeks

Eton Rifles Educated IPA - a seriously hoppy but pale and drinkable West Coast-style craft IPA brewed with English Target and US Equinox hops which give it a punchy aroma and fresh fruity flavour.

Belhaven Black Stout - Deliciously balanced, full bodied stout, offers a rich coffee aroma with lingering hints of dark chocolate and liquorice

Leffe - Abbey Ale that develops a depth from longer maturity. Smooth and malty.

Henley Gold - Lovibonds Brewery - made from yeast from the oldest brewery in the World. Wheat beer

Becks Vier - Made to German purity laws, lighter to drink than classic Becks. Made in Germany

Fruli Strawberry - Unfiltered wheat beer, this light, creamy fresh beer combines lemony fruitiness with gorgeous strawberry flavours and even a hint of mint. Easy to drink and very popular.

Trappist & Abbey ales

Orval - Orange and hoppy with an extremely dry finish. Dry hopped. An authentic Abbey Trappist beer. The nose is yeasty, acidic, hoppy and fruity in a citrus sense. A Truly unique beer. One of the most bitter beers - love it or hate it.

Trappiste Rochefort 10 - Dark authentic Trappist beer. An immense, complex nose. Strong abbey ale.

Chimay Blue Trappist beer - the monks treat their beer as wine. Bottle fermented and tastes like zinfandel grape

Delirium Tremens Blonde - Liquid bread, the beer has yeast and fruit in the nose, but a surprisingly dry flavour, with a more fruit content

Marston's Owd Roger Strong Country Ale - an "own Brew" served here for over 100 years- wish it was still on tap.

La Trappe Blond - This golden ale boasts a rich, fruity and fresh aroma and a light malty sweet taste. It has a soft bitterness with a friendly aftertaste

Duvel - A blonde ale with a frothy white head, heavily hopped yet fruity. Duvel is the most popular beer sold in Belgium

Aecht Schlenkerla Rauchbier - Since 1678 - the barley malt is smoked over beech wood, gives a smokey flavour

La Trappe Dubbel - Deep brown in colour, this beer is rich and malty with a touch of caramel sweetness.
