



Whisky, Rum & Gin

Whisky Islay Distilleries

1. **Laphroaig.** Seaweed aroma. Surprisingly sweet on the palate. £5
2. **Bowmore.** Subtle notes of lemon and honey, on the nose. Dark chocolate and peat smoke on the palate.

Whisky Highland, Isle of Skye

3. **Talisker.** A pungent peaty and sea salt aroma, developing a warm, peppery finish. £5
4. **Glenfiddich.** World's no 1 selling whisky, famed for its' smoothness and quality. £5

Whisky Highland, Tain

5. **Glenmorangie.** Tallest stills. The palate is creamy with hints of nuts and vanilla. Finishing very long. £5

Whisky Lowland, East Lothian

6. **Glenkinchie.** A well-balanced nose between sweet and dry notes. A caramel finish. £5

Whiskey Ireland Antrim

7. **Bushmills Single Malt** 10 year old. Dry heat dries the malted barley not peat and it is made in the oldest licensed distillery in the world (1605 from King James Stuart); winner 'Best Irish Single Malt Whiskey in the World' £5

Whiskey Ireland County Cork

8. **Jameson Irish whiskey** is a popular range of Irish blended whiskeys produced by the Midleton distillery. It provides a slightly stronger alcoholic punch at 43% £3.50

RUM

1. **Pusser's Rum** the rum from the original Royal Navy recipe, using a blend of five West Indian rums. 40% £3.75
2. **Woods 100 Navy** 10 made from the finest sugar cane and distilled in Guyana, South America. Bottled at 57% abv, it is one of the highest percentage volume dark rums out there right now, at least at this price. 0 57% 4.50
3. **Mount Gay Eclipse Rum** Mount Gay is the oldest existing rum brand in the world, with it's oldest surviving deed being from 1703 40% £3

4. **Goslings Black Seal Rum** A brilliant dark rum for sipping or mixing, produced in Bermuda since 1806. The original Dark & Stormy mixed with ginger beer. 40% £3.75
5. **Plantation Stiggings Pineapple Rum** A tribute to the character created by Charles Dickens in the Pickwick Papers, Reverend Stiggins, whose favorite drink was "pineapple rum." 40% £5
6. **The Kraken Spiced Rum** is the first black rum from the Caribbean blended with over 11 secret spices £3.50
7. **Captain Morgan Rum** The Original Rum is blended according to an age-old recipe of rums from Jamaica, Guyana and Barbados.

GIN

1. **Gordons 37.5%** A perfect combination of pure distilled grain spirit and rich botanicals. This attention to detail and high juniper content has earned Gordons the recognition of the "ginniest of gins" £3
2. **Bombay Sapphire 37.5%** . world famous gin in its distinctive blue bottle. Every drop contains 10 hand-selected botanicals from exotic locations around the world. £3.60
3. **Hendricks 41.4%** infuse their gin with the remarkable Bulgarian Rosa Damascena and specially selected cucumbers from the finest producers. Made in Scotland. £4.50
4. **Plymouth. 41.2** The Plymouth Distillery is the oldest working distillery in England. It has been making Plymouth Gin according to the original recipe since 1793. £4
5. **Tanqueray London Dry, 42.1%** one of the most awarded gins in the world since the 1830's. £3
6. **Beefeater Pink 37.5%** Strawberry gin made in London and based on the classic recipe. £3
7. **Blue Bottle Dry Gin** higher in alcohol 47% Traditional juniper doesn't dominate. Astute drinkers will appreciate the tropical scent of local gorse flowers. £4.50
